

10 REASONS TO REUNITE HAITIAN-AMERICAN FAMILIES

1. There are 110,000 Haitian people who have already been approved for visas, but must wait several years to finally enter the United States.
2. Hundreds of thousands of Haitians still live in tents, and substantive reconstruction has yet to begin since the earthquake in the Haitian 4 years ago.
3. Reuniting Haitian-American families does not require legislation. President Obama simply needs to instruct Jeh Johnson, of the Department of Homeland Security to create a program to expedite their visas.
4. There are over 10,000 minors who are already approved for visas and deserve to be reunited with their family members.
5. Haiti is undergoing a crisis due to a cholera outbreak that was introduced by U.N. troops after the earthquake.
6. Haitian migration to the U.S. is typically driven by an unjust international economic system that deprives them of the ability to earn a living wage.
7. A Family Reunification Parole Program to reunite Haitian-American families would significantly reduce the amount of people risking their lives to migrate .
8. Let's get rid of the double standard. There is a Family Reunification Parole Program for Cubans that should be the same model for Haitians.
9. We can win this! Immigration Reform is not happening this year, and the Obama Administration can show their good will towards migrants by creating a program.
10. Justice delayed, is justice denied. Justice for Haitian-Americans means they should be reunited with their family members.
